



Kerry Mechanical Engineering (KME) Agri Warranty Form for Slurry Spreading Equipment

Introduction

KME Agri is committed to providing high-quality slurry spreading equipment to our customers. This warranty form ensures all our customers are satisfied with our slurry spreading equipment. KME Agri warrants that purchased KME Agri slurry spreading equipment will be free from defects in material and workmanlike.

Warranty Coverage:

- The terms of the warranty are considered accepted if no reservation is entered within 15 days of delivery.
- This warranty covers KME Agri equipment for a period of 12 months for farmers' use and 6 months for contractors, from the delivery date. There is no warranty for hire use.
- The invoice date signed by the dealer and the buyer is considered proof of delivery.
- This warranty is limited to the replacement of faulty parts either in material or manufacture which is recognized by the KME Agri factory or technical department.

Warranty Exclusions:

- Parts not manufactured by KME Agri (eg. motor) are not covered by the warranty.
- This warranty does not cover defects that arise as a result of inappropriate use of the product. Therefore, the warranty does not apply to the following:
 - Improper use
 - Inadequate maintenance
 - Any modifications not carried out by KME Agri
 - General wear and tear of the product
 - Accidents caused by negligence
- KME Agri cannot be held liable for complaints or injuries to the owner, a third party, or any other liabilities.
- KME Agri cannot be held to the payment of any indemnity whatsoever for any reason, be it for damage caused by a malfunction, hidden defect, or breakdown of the machine.

User Responsibilities

The user is responsible and must bear the costs of servicing the equipment (minor adjustments, lubrication, maintenance checks, etc.) and parts vulnerable to wear, such as blades and the shear plate.

Customer and Dealer Responsibilities

This warranty is subject to the dealer and the user strictly complying with the following conditions:

- Any faulty parts must be returned to KME Agri for examination. The cost to return the part is to be paid by the sender.
- Servicing and maintenance of the machine must follow the KME Agri operations and maintenance manual.
- Safety measures mentioned in the operation and maintenance manual, as well as on the machine, must be adhered to at all times.
- All protective elements should be checked regularly and kept in good working order.
- This warranty can at no time be transferred to a third party without written consent from KME Agri.
- If a warranty is rejected, the dealer is given a period of 15 days following the receipt of our letter to return the faulty parts. At the end of that period, the parts should be destroyed.
- Assistance given by KME Agri or its authorized dealers in repairing or adjusting equipment does not change or invalidate the warranty conditions.
- Our authorized dealers cannot make warranty decisions on behalf of KME Agri.
- KME Agri reserves the right to change its machine without prior notice and without being bound to carry out these or similar changes to machines already sold or being serviced.
- Because of constant changes in technology, no guarantee can be given concerning the description of the materials listed in KME Agri catalogues.
- KME Agri's decision is final and irrevocable.
- This warranty releases KME Agri from all further legal or contractual responsibilities.

Limitations of Liability

KME Agri is not liable for incidental or consequential damages. liability is limited to the repair, replacement or refund of the faulty part.
